

Year 7 Music

Term 2 Course Outline

In this 10 week unit of Music, students will learn the basics of music with a focus on the elements of music; texture, harmony & pitch. Students will participate in individual performances on piano, drums and guitar to demonstrate their understanding of these elements. We will analyse music through the elements of music and experience music from other cultures and countries. Students will also complete a creative writing task which is to create a media package

Learning Outcomes

Students will be assessed on the following Learning Outcomes:
