

# 7 - 10 Band & Choir Program

## Semester 1 Course Outline

Students will learn the basics of music with a focus on the elements of music; texture, harmony & pitch. Students will participate in individual and group performances on their chosen instrument to demonstrate their understanding of these elements.

### Learning Outcomes

Students will be assessed on the following Learning Outcomes:
