Students in Peer Mentor will act as positive role models to the Year 7 students at school. Students will develop and deliver a Values Education and Resilience Program to Year 7 Long TEAM. The students will gain skills in leadership, peer mediation, conflict resolution and behaviour management as well as develop strategies to enhance group dynamics and learning.
