

Year 7 Maths (Learning Support)

Semester 1 Course Outline

This semester we will begin with a unit on number and place value. Students will solve problems and explore mathematical strategies using the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). They will participate in games and hands-on activities that reinforce number skills. We will also look at patterns and algebraic concepts such as missing numbers. Our focus will then turn to fractions, decimals, percentages and money/financial maths. Students will incorporate their knowledge into real-life maths activities. All assessment will be completed during class time.
