Apart from being a much-needed upgrade to old facilities, it will enhance the learning experience for our students and enable the Certificate 2 in Hospitality to be taught at Mt Stromlo High School.

COURSES FOR YEAR 9 AND 10 STUDENTS

First Aid Course

Stromlo High has secured a trainer from Canberra First Aid to run the course at Mount Stromlo High School. They have limited places on offer so it will be those who return their permission notes and pay, who will secure their places first. The course is delivered in two parts. The first is an online component which needs to be completed before the course date. This section will be started during school hours two weeks before the training day but will need to be finished at home. Then students will then engage in a full day of practical training and assessment.
