### **LANGUAGES**


# 2024 Dates and Specialisations

- Submit your application <u>here</u> by Friday
   3 May 2024.

Students of all backgrounds are welcome to apply. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are strongly encouraged to apply, as are students from diverse cultural and linguistic backgrounds.

The program is in high demand and the number of applications outweighs the number of places available. All applications will be assessed by a panel based on application, areas of interest and available dates. Successful applicants for 2024 will be notified the week of Monday, 3 June 2024.





The ASD Work Experience Program (WEx) is designed for students in years 11 and 12 who have a passion to learn more about ICT, cyber security, programming and network engineering. High achieving year 10 students may be considered if they can display the level of skill and knowledge required.

Work Experience placements are open to students around Australia. The program is held in Canberra however almost half of students are from interstate including Queensland, Victoria, South Australia and New South Wales, so we encourage students from all over Australia to apply.
