

# Year 7 Drama

## Term 3 Course Outline

In this course, students will take part in a variety of exercises and performance games that are designed to help develop skills in cooperation, communication, group and self-awareness, self-esteem and self-discipline. They will be introduced to the elements of drama and use these to underpin their own performance work.
