# OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Across week 8, both Outdoor Education classes embarked on an Alpine Camp in Kosciuszko National Park. The focus of this semester is survival in the outdoors. While weather looked like it would stop us in our tracks (again) we were very lucky to have wonderfully blue and sunny skies, a slight breeze and a dusting of snow on the Friday. Students got to play in the snow, build improvised shelters, and practice lightweight camping skills such as cooking on a Trangia, setting up a tent and hiking or snowshoeing. This camp pushed our students out of their comfort zones where they slept in temperatures below 0 and hiked/snowshoed through snow. While hiking up steep switchbacks, setting up tents in strong winds, digging through the snow to make a group shelter and cooking in alpine environments is tough work, it was fantastic to see each student with a smile on their face at the end of the camp!

#### UPDATED BUS TIMETABLE

Transport Canberra has announced today that a <u>new bus timetable</u> will be implemented from Monday 9 October to align with the start of the school Term 4.

The timetable features more frequent weekday bus services, most of which will run at least every 30 minutes throughout the day.

A return to 30-minute daytime frequencies will ensure improved off-peak services can be provided between 9.30am and 3.30pm, while maintaining reliability. The increased frequency has resulted in changes to the first and last service times for some bus routes.

Some refinements have also been made to 14 school services based on school and community feedback, and to align with updated school bell times.
