

Year 10 CIT Industry Pathways

Semester 2 Course Outline

Students will develop employability skills and will explore different industries. The course will bring the world of work into the classroom and also take students into the world of work. Through the course, students will take part in interviews, worksite visits/placements, external training in an adult learning environment and project-based and online learning. Students will also benefit from interactions with employers/employees, self-employed people, entrepreneurs and various guest speakers.
