Semester 2 Course Outline

Students in Peer Mentor will act as positive role models to the Year 6 students transitioning to high school. Students will develop and deliver a Values Education Program to Year 6 through visits to the cluster primary schools. The students will gain skills in leadership, peer mediation, conflict resolution and behaviour management as well as develop strategies to enhance group dynamics and learning.
